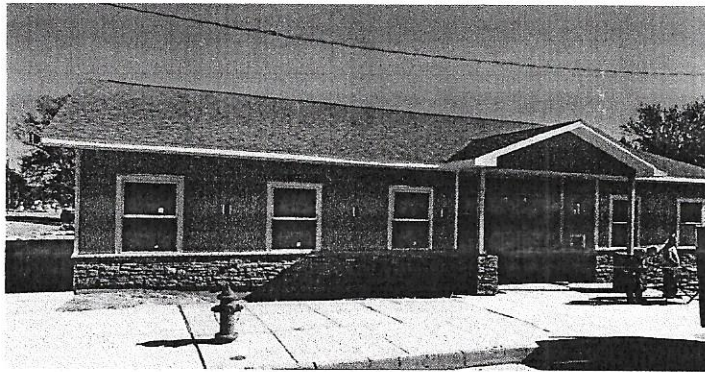

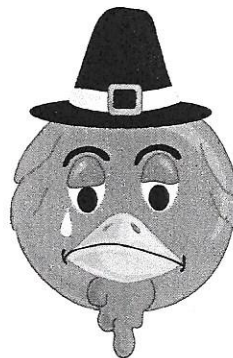

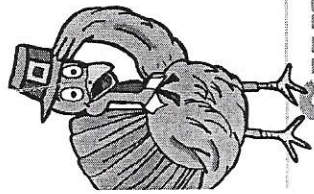
## Still Available

Would you be interested in "buying" a shelf or a complete unit in your name or in memory or honor of a family member? There are still units or bookshelves needed.

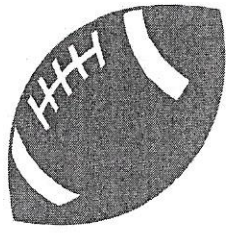
