Dessert Crepes

4 eggs, lightly beaten

2 T sugar

1 1/3 cups milk

½ tsp salt

2 T butter, melted

Whisk together eggs, milk, flour, melted butter, sugar, and salt in a large bowl until smooth.

Heat a medium skillet or crepe pan over medium heat. Grease the pan with a small amount of butter or oil applied with a brush or paper towel.

Using a serving spoon or small ladle, spoon about 3 tablespoons crepe batter onto the hot pan, tilting the pan to evenly coat the bottom surface. Cook until golden brown, 1 to 2 minutes per side.

Serve warm with fillings and toppings, such as, blueberries, strawberries, raspberries, bananas, cool whip, cream cheese whipped cream, lemon curd, Nutella chocolate hazelnut spread, toasted coconut, or toasted almonds.
